COMMUNITY



More than 350,000 people call Davis County home in bustling urban centers like Layton and Bountiful, suburban family havens, and the wide open rural spaces in-between. Locals and visitors are finding all the entertainment, dining, and shopping options they need.

Between Great Salt Lake and the Wasatch Mountains, Davis features sunrises and sunsets that will leave you breathless. Beyond aesthetic appeal, these geographical features provide the community with limitless recreational opportunities. Hikers and bikers enjoy more than 500 miles of trails to explore. Comprehensive maps with trail descriptions are available at daviscountyutah.gov/trails - or pick up a FREE Trails & Bikeways map at any city office or bike shop in Davis County.

Unique wildlife viewing opportunities are available at Antelope Island State Park. Bison, antelope, deer, coyotes, and bighorn sheep can be seen roaming freely on the island. Each May the Great Salt Lake Bird Festival attracts bird enthusiasts from across the world to experience millions of diverse fowl migrating through the Pacific Flyway. Jerry Liguori, a renowned birder and author said. "The Great Salt Lake Bird Festival is one of the most unique festivals in the United States. Field trips are held at some of the most amazing wildlife areas in the world and they are abundant with wildlife."











Discover Davis and find a thriving arts culture comprised of museums, community theatre, music festivals and art galleries. Begin your cultural exploration with our listings on page 6 of this guide. CenterPoint Legacy Theatre in Centerville offers a variety of high-quality musical theatre productions year round, and the Davis Arts Council proudly presents local artists and popular music artists alike on the Edward A. Kenley Centennial Amphitheatre Stage in Layton.

Although Davis living is attractive to commuters working in Salt Lake City and Ogden, the local employment market is also booming. Hill Air Force Base boasts 5,000 active duty and reserve Air Force, 15,000 civilians, and 3,500 government contractors- pumping \$4 billion into the local economy annually.

The Davis School District is the second largest in the state, with 59 elementary schools, 17 junior high schools, and 9 high schools. Outstanding educators and administrators prepare students for higher education by partnering with local colleges and universities. They offer 95 different concurrent enrollment college courses to high school students in the district.

Davis is booming. The population is expected to double by 2050 with safe communities, high-quality education, dining, entertainment and recreational opportunities that abound here in Discover Davis: Utah's Amusement Capital.

ANTELOPE ISLAND STATE PARK









When you want to get away from it all—but not too far away—Antelope Island is Davis County's very own wilderness oasis.

A short seven-mile causeway is all that separates the bustle of Davis County from Antelope Island State Park—but the wildlife refuge and state park in the middle of Utah's world famous Great Salt Lake still feels a world away.

First documented by John C. Fremont and Kit Carson in 1845, Antelope Island was named after the wildlife that make the island their home. Now that home is protected by a 28,000-acre State Park. To this day an incredible variety of birds and a herd of 600 bison—as well as coyote, big horn sheep, mule deer, and pronghorn (antelope)— thrive in an isolated oasis where visitors come for spectacular views of the animals, tours of a historical homestead and unique recreational opportunities.

The Fielding Garr Ranch is the first permanent residence on the island, built in 1848. Still standing on its original foundations, the ranch house and surrounding buildings are a fascinating piece of Utah history to explore.

But there is far more to discover in this close-to-home wilderness. More than 50 miles of non-motorized trails crisscrossing the island are ideal for hiking, horseback riding, and biking. Canoes and kayaks launch from the marina, and swimming in the highly saline water is best at Bridger Bay Beach where showers and restrooms are available.



OUTDOORS



HOW WILL YOU DISCOVER DAVIS?

Davis County's western bank begins at the hemisphere's largest saltwater lake and then climbs eastward more than a vertical mile to Thurston Peak in the Wasatch Mountains. The transition from lakeshore to foothill to mountain range creates incredible geographical, geological, biological and recreational diversity. Bring a couple of footwear options and you can hike, bike, boat, golf and ski in a single afternoon.

So skip the question, "What is there to do in Davis?" Instead ask, "How will I Discover Davis today?"

By Water

Between the Great Salt Lake and all the creeks, ponds and reservoirs, more than half of Davis is under water. This creates a lot of opportunity for outdoor recreation.

There's great fishing at Holmes Creek Reservoir, Bountiful Pond, Farmington Pond, Hobbs Pond, Andy Adams Pond and Kaysville Ponds (bluegill, largemouth bass, channel catfish and trout); or try fly fishing at Farmington Creek. You can go for a float in the super-buoyant Great Salt Lake or, for a surreal sunset, head to Antelope Island.

By Air

The famously variable shore of the Great Salt Lake makes for acres of wetlands that are the perfect stop for local and migrating birds. You'll have a very successful bird-watching year between Farmington Bay Waterfowl Management Area, The Great Salt Lake Shorelands Preserve and, 25 minutes north, the Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge. Meet up with other birders at the Great Salt Lake Bird Festival, or try a guided tour from the Wild About Birds Nature Center.







By Land

Davis County is the smallest county by land area in Utah, but it has more than 500 miles of trails. Walk, run, hike, bike or push a stroller on anything from the paved Legacy Parkway Trail to the singletracks climbing the canyons of the Wasatch Mountains. Here are a few to get you started.

Distance: 7.8 miles Difficulty: Moderate Lots of hikers and bikers and even horses.

Wild Rose - North Salt Lake

Distance: 2.4 miles Difficulty: Moderate A hike & bike network with abundant flowers in the spring.

Bonneville Shoreline Trail - Logan to Nephi

Distance: 100+ miles Difficulty: Easy to Moderate Runs along the ancient lakeshore connecting many other trails.

Adams Canyon - Layton

Distance: 3.5 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Features a 40' waterfall.

Holbrook Canyon - Bountiful

Distance: 6 miles Difficulty: Advanced Come ready to climb, cross streams and navigate.

Parrish Creek - Centerville

Distance: 8.7 miles Difficulty: Hard

Best route for climbing Bountiful Peak from the west.

Farmington Creek Trail - Farmington Distance: 2.5 miles Difficulty: Easy

Perfect paved path for families. Don't miss it in the fall.

Hobbs Canyon Trail - Layton

Distance: 2.2 miles Difficulty: Moderate Pretty walk along the North Fork of Kays Creek.


